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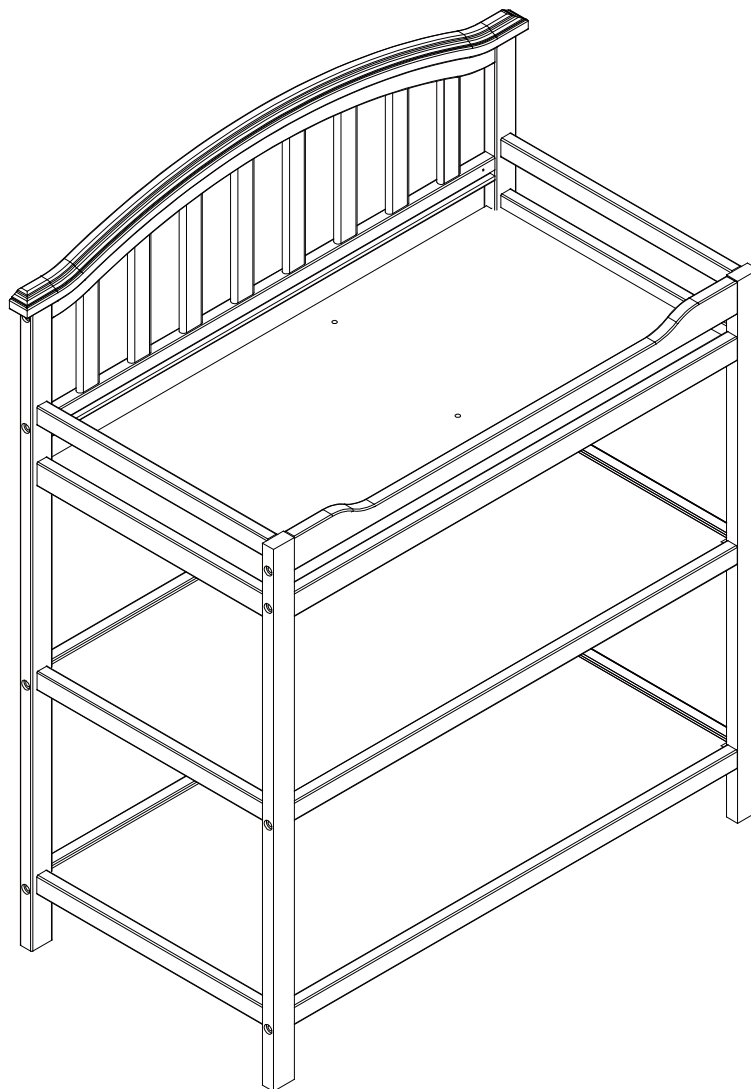
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Berkley Changing Table Assembly Instruction

Changing Table Warnings



WARNING

Fall Hazard - Children have suffered serious injuries after falling from changing tables. Falls can happen quickly.

Stay In arm's reach of your child.

Always secure this pad to the changing table surface by strap. See instructions.

Suffocation Hazard Babies have suffocated while sleeping on changing tables: changing table is not designed for safe sleep.

Do not put a child to sleep or leave a sleeping child in or on this accessory.

Do not use this accessory if you cannot exactly follow the instructions that come with it. **Do not** use the changing table if it is damaged or broken.

Do not leave a child unattended in or on this accessory.

Child must be no more than 30 lbs. to use this changing table.

Use only the pad provided by C&T International / Sorelle or Manufacturer's

**WHEN CHILD REACHES A MAXIMUM WEIGHT OF 30 LBS.,
THE CHANGING TABLE SHALL NO LONGER BE USED**

NOTES ON ASSEMBLY:

- During the assembly process whenever using screws or bolts, check each by placing the screw/bolt on the diagram of the item which is drawn actual size and design. Be sure to use the proper size and shape specified in the instructions.
- To assemble this unit you may be required to place the unit on it's side and face. It is strongly recommended that assembly is done on a soft, non-abrasive surface to avoid damaging the finish.

NOTES ON USE:

Keep children and others safe by following these simple rules:

- **Do not** allow any child to play on furniture
- **Do not** allow climbing on any piece of furniture.
- **Do not** allow hanging from any piece of furniture.
- Always monitor your child's activity when in the nursery.

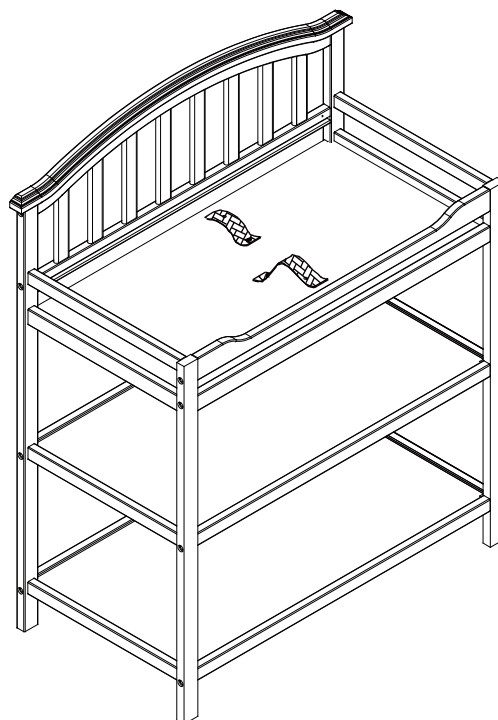
NOTES ON CARE AND MAINTENANCE:

- **Do not** scratch or chip the finish.
- Inspect the product periodically, contact C&T International / Sorelle for replacement parts or questions.
- **Do not** store the product or any parts in extreme temperatures and conditions such as a hot attic or a damp, cold basement. These extremes can cause a loss of structural integrity.
- To preserve the luster of the high quality finish on your product, it is recommended to place a daily or felt pad under any items you place on the finish.
- Clean with a damp cloth, then a dry cloth to preserve the original luster and beauty of this fine finish.
- Do not** use abrasive chemicals.
- Do not** spray cleaners directly onto furniture.
- Lift slightly when moving on carpeting to prevent leg breakage.
- Use of a vaporizer near furniture will cause wood to swell and finish to peel.

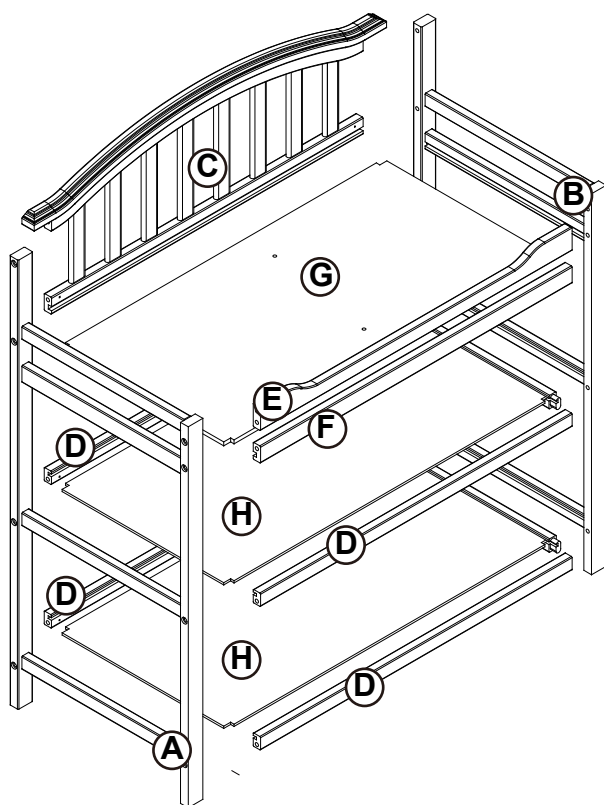

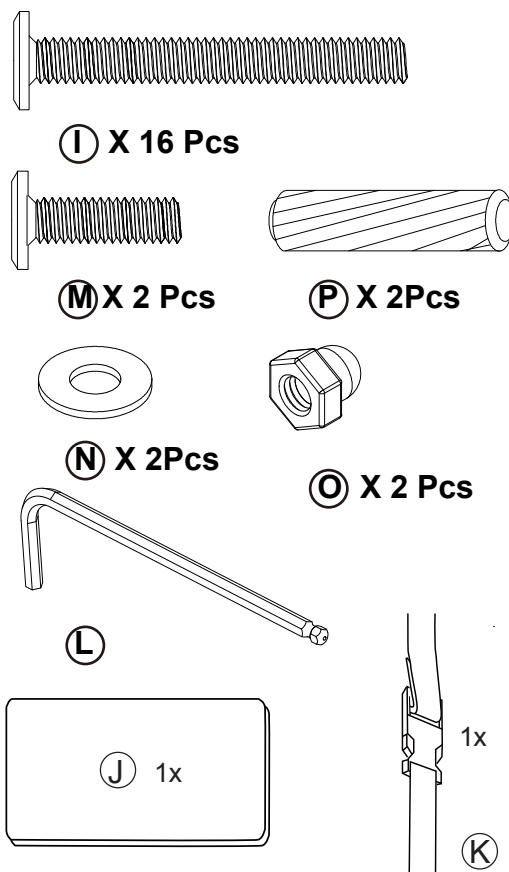

Important: In order to properly assemble the changing table, carry out the operations in order specified. Failure to assemble the changing table in the manner recommended could make the changing table hazardous

Changing Table Assembly Steps

Step 1 Connect Rails to Left Frame using 8 Bolts(I)&1 Wood dowel (P) as Figure 1 shows.

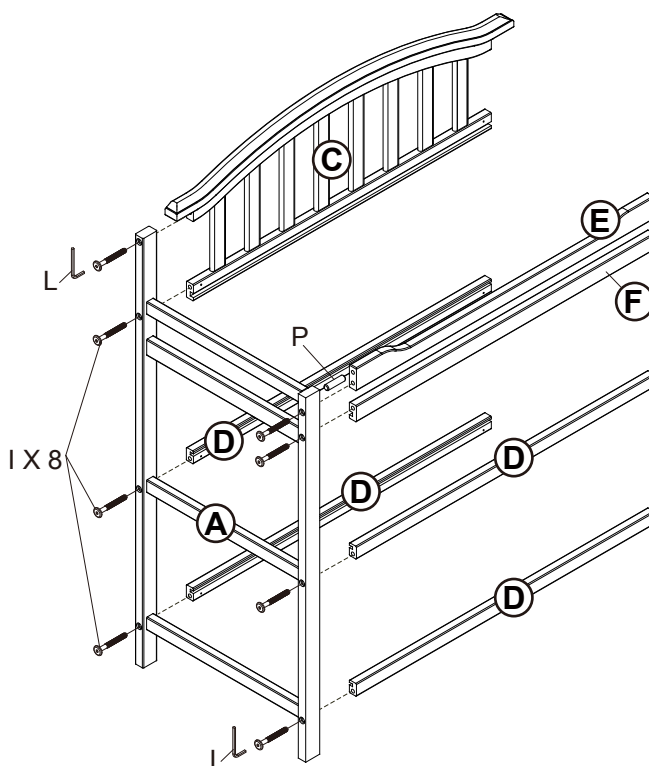

Step 2 Shelves Assembly
Slide the shelves through the grooves in the Rails and Back Frame as figure 2 shows.

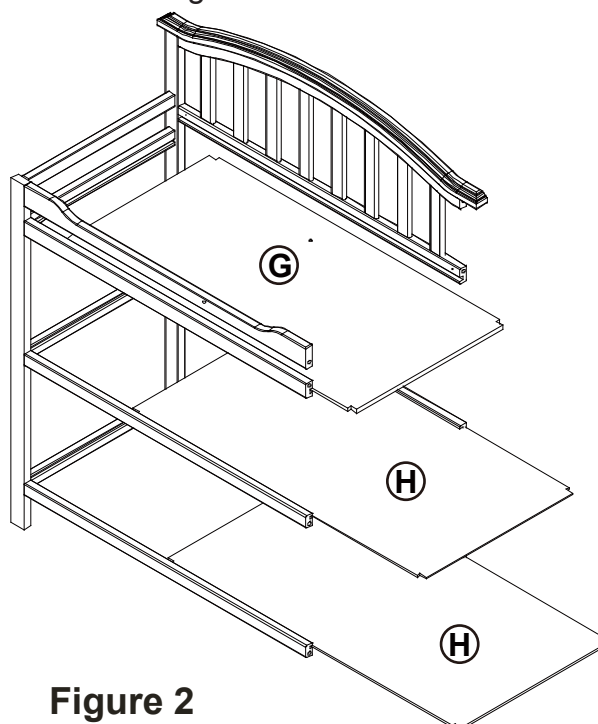
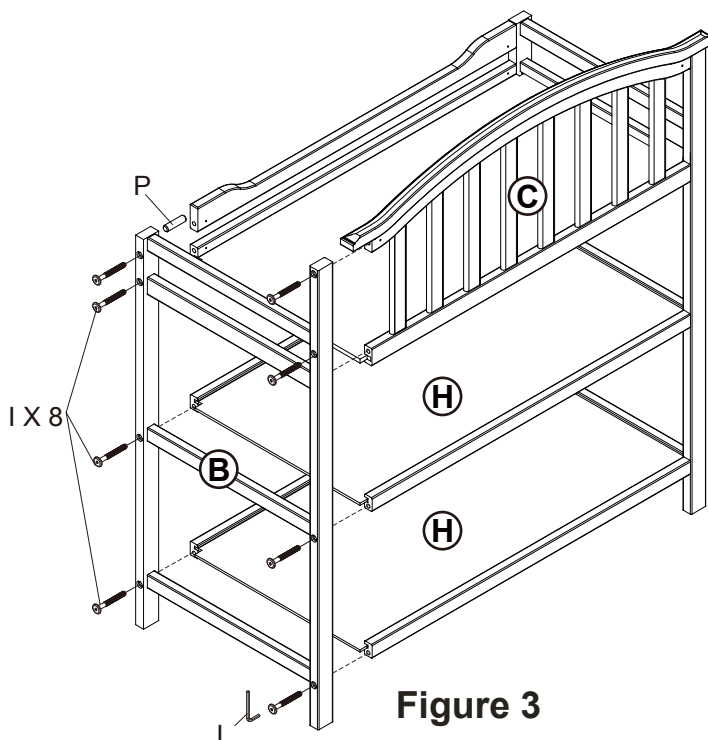

Changing Table Assembly Steps

Step 3 Connect Right Frame To Changing Table using 8 Bolts(I) & 1 Wood dowel(P) as Figure 3 shows.



Tighten all Bolts

Step 4 Safety Harness Assembled as Figure 4 shows.

Step 1

To attach the safety harness, place the safety harness (Part "K") on the top shelf and align the hole on the safety harness end with the hole on the top shelf

Step 2

Insert the bolt (Part "M") through a washer (Part "N"), the harness hole and the top shelf hole.

Step 3

Secure with a nut (Part "O") on the underside of the top shelf.

Step 4

Repeat the process to attach the other side of the harness to the top shelf.

Step 5

Place changing pad on top of safety harness.

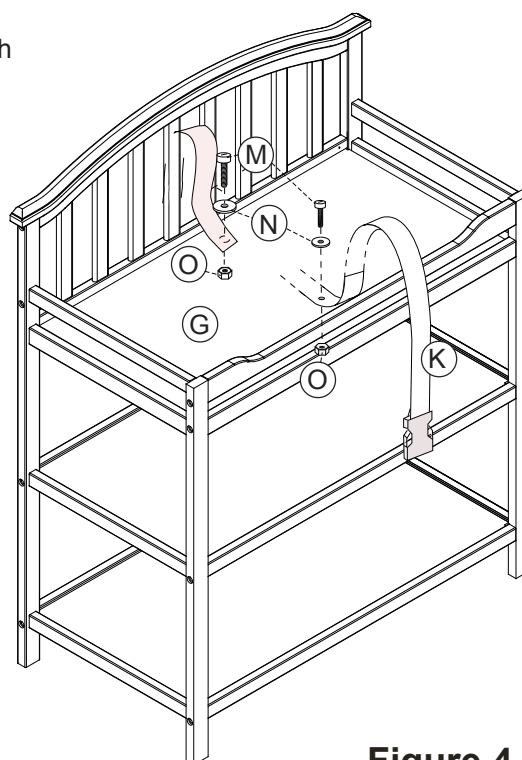

SAFETY HARNESS/RESTRAINT SYSTEM USE

1. Place the infant on the changing table foam pad
2. Position the safety harness over the middle of the infant's torso and insert the buckled ends into each other until they lock shut with a click.
3. Gently pull the loose end of the safety to lightly snug the safety harness around the infant.
